I am writing to inquire whether you would be willing and able to participate in a religious arbitration concerning a dispute between two former Scientologists and several Scientology churches concerning claims made by the former for refunds of donations made to such churches. The arbitration will be conducted pursuant to the provision of Enrollment Agreements establishing such arbitration to resolve disputes. It requires that the arbitration be conducted by three Scientologists in good standing. I will instruct the arbitrators of the requirement of applying Scientology policy to the dispute in a neutral and fair manner, as required.

It is important that you do not discuss this matter with others at this time. Any communications should be made only to me as International Justice Chief.

The arbitration has not been scheduled, but should take place sometime within the next 3 months, depending on the availability of the three arbitrators who will be selected and of the parties to the arbitration. There is no ecclesiastical requirement that you participate in this procedure; it is entirely a matter of your willingness and availability.

Please advise me at your earliest convenience if you are able to do so, and when.
